Practising Tasmanian teachers were commissioned to write resources for their colleagues, both within the state and further afield. The resources are concept-based and explore musical ideas through age-appropriate activities in singing, playing, moving, listening, commenting and creating, and align with the Music National Curriculum. All the resources are free; some are supported by audio files, others make use of any standard version of the repertoire involved.
