

Nathaniel Griffiths is a Hobart-based conductor and trombone player, currently studying at the University of Tasmania Conservatorium of Music. Born in Mackay (QLD) and beginning his musical education in Blackwater, he started learning the euphonium at age 9. Since, he has already travelled the world in pursuit of his craft; in 2010, he was part of the Pacific Honours Ensemble Program and travelled to Seattle, and in 2012 was a delegate at the International Tuba Euphonium Conference in Linz, Austria. Until June 2017, Nathaniel was a euphonium and trombone major at the Griffith Conservatorium of Music (QLD), and has moved to Hobart in pursuit of a conducting education with Johannes Fritzsich.

Whilst residing in Brisbane, he was engaged as a conductor by the Indooroopilly Chamber Orchestra, Queensland Korean Orchestra Junior Strings, and Sunnybank Brass Bands, as well as in performances with the Queensland Conservatorium Brass Band. Presently, he is engaged as a guest conductor with Glenorchy City Concert Brass, one of Australia's premier brass bands. Additionally, he participates in weekly masterclasses in score reading and conducting technique with Johannes Fritzsich. Nathaniel hopes to pursue a career as a professional orchestral conductor, whilst remaining active as a trombonist.
