## TERMS, CONDITIONS & GUIDELINES

Please read and carefully consider the following Terms, Conditions and Guidelines for ***The Ugly Sound Animation Competition*** before submitting your animation.

### ALL ENTRANTS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING:

By entering the TSO *The Ugly Sound Animation Competition* ('Competition'), competition entrants ('Entrants') agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions. Failure to abide by these terms and conditions may render an Entrant ineligible for the Competition.

1. Entrants must submit their entries by email to Jenny Compton [comptonj@tso.com.au](mailto:comptonj@tso.com.au) and provide:
  - A) A Google Drive link to MP4 file of the animation being entered.
  - B) Attached pdf, doc or docx completed entry form **ONLY**.  
(typed text only, handwritten forms will not be accepted)
2. To be eligible for the Competition, Entrants must submit the completed entry form and Google Drive link by the close of entries: **Midday AEST, Friday 10 May 2019**.
3. The competition is only open to students enrolled in grades 7-12 (or equivalent, if home schooled) in 2019. All entrants must be Australian residents.
4. Entrants must use the audio excerpt **The Ugly Sound Animation Competition Clip.MP3** provided by the TSO as the soundtrack for their animation. The audio excerpt provided may not be altered in any way.
5. Text is not allowed to be included in the animation, with the exception of the title: The Ugly Sound.
6. The Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra (TSO) reserves the right to use Entrant's content in any manner they choose. Submission of an entry constitutes consent by the Entrant for the TSO to use the content in this way and also to use the Entrant's name for publicity purposes.

Entries become the property of TSO. The non-exclusive worldwide rights for all media submitted must be available in perpetuity for use by TSO.
7. All visual content must be the original work of the entrant. Entrants are responsible for making sure their animation does not infringe copyright in any way.
8. Inappropriate or offensive content will result in disqualification. If in doubt, ask a teacher to check your animation is suitable.
9. The Competition judges' decisions are final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into regarding the judging process or any outcomes reached.
10. Entrants' home address, mobile telephone number and email address is collected solely for the purposes of administering this contest and shall not be used for any other purpose without your consent. By providing this information, you consent to this information being used by the TSO for the stated purposes.

## TO ENTER

1. Download the audio excerpt **The Ugly Sound Animation Competition Clip.MP3** provided on the TSO website.
2. Create an animation using this audio as the soundtrack.
3. The only text allowed to be displayed, is the title: The Ugly Sound.
4. Export file as an MP4.
5. Label your MP4 file as follows:  
TSOTUS Surname date (day-month-year).MP4  
For example: TSOTUS Compton 03-12-2018.MP4
6. Upload your MP4 file to a Google Drive.
7. Fill out the entry form and save to your computer as a doc, docx or pdf.

  - A) A Google Drive link to the MP4 file of the animation being entered.
  - B) Attached PDF or Doc. of the completed entry form

## FINALISTS AND WINNERS

Up to ten finalists will be selected for placement in a final round of judging.

The entrant whose submission best captures the story “sound” characters and is considered the most engaging, imaginative and innovative, will be deemed the winner.
