Vivian Horn is currently a postgraduate candidate at the Elder Conservatorium (Adelaide University) where she is studying conducting with Dr Luke Dollman. In 2019, she has been an orchestral assisting conductor to Nicholas Carter and Dalia Stasevska at The Adelaide Symphony Orchestra.

She has undertaken masterclasses with The Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra's Louise Crossley Female Conducting Workshop (Maestro Elena Schwarz) and Australian conducting Academy with The Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra (Johannes Fritzsich), The London Classic Soloists (Achim Holub) and Sinfonietta Cracovia (Jorma Panula). Vivian also had the opportunity to meet Polish mentor Dr Monika Stefaniak who has provided further conducting perspectives and encouragement.

Over the last few years, Vivian has been a regular guest conductor of The Bayside Chamber Orchestra and has worked with The Frankston Symphony and Surrey Hills Orchestras, in Melbourne, Australia.

Vivian graduated with a Master of Music Performance Studies (majoring in piano) under Geoffrey Tozer at the University of Melbourne and she was mentored in conducting by Australian Conductor John Hopkins. She is currently a music educator in piano and conductor at Methodist Ladies' College.
