Audition Requirements:

Set Works

Piece no 1 - David Concertino 1st Mvt, 4 bars before Fig A to Fig D, **OR** Saint-Saens Cavatine for Trombone & Piano

AND

Piece no 2 - David Concertino 2nd Mvt, Cadenza to end, **OR** Weber Romance for Trombone & Piano, beginning to bar 68

Orchestral Excerpts:

- (Please Note Orchestral Excerpts will be released 4 weeks prior to the audition day, or 4 weeks before a confirmed recording date, and upon receipt of a fully completed application)

Recorded Auditions:

All recordings must be received at the TSO soon after your recording date, and no later than 4.00pm Tuesday 9 November 2021.)
