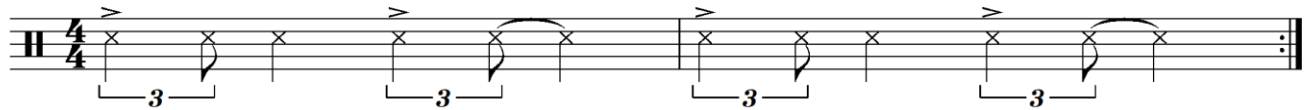


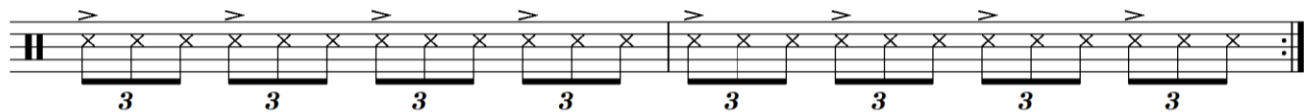
TRIPLET PRACTICE
