Our organisation | The Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra (TSO) is one of Australia's leading performing arts companies and part of the DNA of Tasmanian cultural life – we have been inspiring, invigorating, and entertaining audiences through music since 1948. We are recognised across the island and throughout the world for our distinctive artistic identity that is forged from our people and our place. Our 47-piece orchestra performs an extensive and varied concert season in Hobart, a smaller season in Launceston, and concerts across regional Tasmania; as well as undertaking a significant recording schedule; delivering meaningful community engagement projects; and delivering intensive training programs for players, composers, and conductors.
